POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Manager of Planning, Evaluation and Communications, the Epidemiologist is responsible for: providing leadership and support to health unit surveillance activities that is consistent with the mission, vision, values, objectives, policies and standards of the Board of Health; collecting, analyzing, monitoring, interpreting and disseminating demographic and population health assessment data to support planning and decision-making; providing epidemiological expertise and analytical support to outbreak and cluster investigations; assisting in the implementation of the Ontario Public Health Standards 2021; conducting research on priority populations and emerging health status trends; preparing data/statistics and information for briefings, reports and/or presentations to a variety of audiences; and, reviewing proposed research projects with regards to methodology and analyses.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Masters of Science in Epidemiology or an equivalent combination of experience and education
- Minimum of three years' experience in epidemiology and research, with epidemiology experience in a public health setting

- Experience using statistical (e.g. Stata), data visualization (e.g. PowerBI), and Microsoft Office software packages

- Comprehensive knowledge and demonstrated skills in epidemiological and statistical methods, applied research, and current related best practices
- Familiarity with current public health issues and the <u>Ontario Public Health Standards (2021)</u>
- Demonstrated knowledge of applicable legislation
